GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE ROYAL WEDDING COIN NOTICE 2011

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for Finance has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the Royal Wedding Coin Notice 2011.

Issue of new coin.

2.(1) The new coins of gold, silver and cupro-nickel in the denomination of £1, £5 and One Crown respectively shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coin, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II and Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coin authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design featuring HRH Prince William & Catherine Middleton with the inscription “H.R.H PRINCE WILLIAM & MISS CATHERINE

MIDDLETON WEDDING CELEBRATION
WESTMINSTER ABBEY APRIL 29TH 2011”.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
