LEGAL NOTICE NO. 464 OF 2020

GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE 2020 BATTLE OF BRITAIN COLLECTION – NEVER WAS SO MUCH OWED – PART 2 COIN NOTICE 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice–

Title and commencement.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the 2020 Battle of Britain Collection – Never Was So Much Owed – Part 2 Coin Notice 2020 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold and silver in the denomination of a Quarter, Half, One, Double/Two and Five/Quintuple Sovereigns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part VII of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II DEI GRA REGINA GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge, date of the year below;
- (b) the reverse design of the quarter sovereign depicts an image of the Home Guard with their binoculars in hand and eyes in the sky. An image of a spitfire is depicted above with the number “80”;
- (c) the reverse design of the half sovereign depicts an image of the Home Guard with their binoculars in hand and eyes in the sky together with an image of St Paul’s Cathedral in the background and the number “80”;

- (d) the reverse design of the sovereign depicts an image of the Home Guard with their binoculars in hand and eyes in the sky, two spitfires are depicted above together with an image of St Paul's Cathedral in the background and the number "80"; and
- (e) the reverse design of the double and quintuple sovereign depicts an image of the Home Guard with their binoculars in hand and eyes in the sky, two spitfires are depicted above together with an image of St Paul's Cathedral in the background. The inscription around the edge of the coin reads "NEVER WAS SO MUCH OWED BY SO MANY TO SO FEW".

Legal Tender.

- 4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
