## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

### ISSUE OF WINSTON CHURCHILL: 150<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY COLLECTION PART TWO COINS NOTICE 2025

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice—

#### **Title and commencement.**

1. This notice may be cited as the issue of the Winston Churchill: 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Collection Part Two Coins Notice 2025 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of gold in the denominations of 1/25 Crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the design depicts the newly sculpted Raphael Maklouf effigy of King Charles III and the Latin inscription reading; • CHARLES III • D • G • REX • F • D • GIBRALTAR •, which reads as; • CHARLES III • BY THE GRACE OF GOD • DEFENDER OF THE FAITH • KING OF GIBRALTAR • and includes the denomination and the year in which the coin is struck; and
- (b) each reverse design features an image of Winston Churchill at various stages of the war along with an inscription taken from his most famous speeches, ‘LET US GO FORWARD TOGETHER, ‘WE SHALL FIGHT ON THE BEACHES’, ‘BLOOD, TOIL, TEARS AND SWEAT’ and ‘NEVER WAS SO MUCH OWED BY SO MANY TO SO FEW’.

**Legal Tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
