Title.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Service Commission Regulations.

Interpretation.

- 2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,-
 - "chairman" means the chairman of the Public Service Commission;
 - "Commission" means the Public Service Commission;
 - "member" means a member of the Commission;
 - "officer", in relation to the Commission, means the secretary to or any other officer of the Commission, appointed under regulation 3;

Appointment of Staff.

- 3. (1) The Governor may appoint any public officer or other person to be the secretary to the Commission.
- (2) The Governor may appoint any other public officers or other persons to be officers of the Commission.
 - (3) No person appointed under this regulation shall—
 - (a) be a member of the Commission; or
 - (b) participate in the proceedings of the Commission or vote on any question that is the subject matter of its deliberations.

Powers of Commission to conduct examinations and appoint boards.

- 4. (1) The Commission may conduct such examinations, interviews and investigations, and appoint such selection, promotion or other boards as it may consider necessary for the proper discharge of its functions.
- (2) Any board may consist wholly or partly of persons who are not members of the Commission.
- (3) The Commission may delegate to any board any of the functions of the Commission relating to the examination or interview of or investigation of any circumstances affecting candidates for appointment, promotion or
