**PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

**Title.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Service Commission Regulations.

**Interpretation.**

2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,-

“chairman” means the chairman of the Public Service Commission;

“Commission” means the Public Service Commission;

“member” means a member of the Commission;

“officer”, in relation to the Commission, means the secretary to or any other officer of the Commission, appointed under regulation 3;

“secretary” means the secretary to the Commission.

**Appointment of Staff.**

3. (1) The Governor may appoint any public officer or other person to be the secretary to the Commission.

(2) The Governor may appoint any other public officers or other persons to be officers of the Commission.

(3) No person appointed under this regulation shall—

(a) be a member of the Commission; or

(b) participate in the proceedings of the Commission or vote on any question that is the subject matter of its deliberations.

**Powers of Commission to conduct examinations and appoint boards.**

4. (1) The Commission may conduct such examinations, interviews and investigations, and appoint such selection, promotion or other boards as it may consider necessary for the proper discharge of its functions.

(2) Any board may consist wholly or partly of persons who are not members of the Commission.

(3) The Commission may delegate to any board any of the functions of the Commission relating to the examination or interview of or investigation of any circumstances affecting candidates for appointment, promotion or

transfer to any public office, or the termination of any appointment to any public office, or the dismissal or disciplinary control of any public officer.

### Oaths.

5. (1) Every member shall, on first appointment, take before the Deputy Governor an oath in the form set out in Schedule 1.

(2) Every person (not being a member of the Commission) who is an officer, or is a member of a board appointed under regulation 4, shall on first appointment take before the chairman an oath in the form set out in Schedule 2.

### SCHEDULE 1.

Regulation 5(1).

#### OATH OF MEMBER.

I, . . . . . having been appointed as chairman/member of the Public Service Commission, do swear that I will freely and without fear or favour, affection or ill-will give my counsel and advice to the Governor of Gibraltar in connection with all such questions or matters as are or may be referred to the Public Service Commission by or under the Constitution, and that I will not, directly or indirectly, reveal any such matters to any unauthorized person or otherwise than in the course of duty.

**OATH OF OFFICER OF THE COMMISSION.**
