ORDINANCE 1990.**

**GIBRALTAR DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION  
(EMPLOYER'S INSOLVENCY)(AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS 1991.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 26 of the Gibraltar Development Corporation Ordinance 1990, the Government has made the following regulations—

**Title.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Gibraltar Development Corporation (Employer's Insolvency)(Amendment)Regulations 1991.

**Amendment to regulations 4.**

2. Regulation 4 of the Gibraltar Development Corporation (Employer's Insolvency) Regulations 1991 is amended—

(a) in sub-regulation (6) by omitting paragraph (b) and substituting therefor the following paragraph—

“(b) not reveal—

- (i) except for the purpose of enforcing any statutory or legal obligation, information;
- (ii) at any time, even after ceasing to be an Inspector, any manufacturing or commercial secrets or working processes,

which may come to his knowledge in the course of his duties.”;

(b) by inserting after sub-regulation (8) the following new sub-regulation (9)—

“(9) Any person being employed in the administration of these regulations—

- (a) shall, subject to the proviso to this sub-regulation, regard information obtained in the exercise of the powers contained in these regulations as confidential;
- (b) shall not be required to produce in any court any document or to divulge or communicate to any court any matter or thing coming under his notice in the performance of his duties under these regulations except as may be necessary for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of these regulations or any ordinance or in order to institute a prosecution or in the course of a prosecution for any offence committed in relation to these regulations or any Ordinance:

Provided that nothing contained in this sub-regulation shall preclude a person employed in the administration of these regulations, at the request of the Financial and Development secretary, providing to him such information relating to any matter referred to in this sub-regulation as the Government of Gibraltar may require for the purpose of formulating the economic and fiscal policies of the Government.”.
