GIBRALTAR DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ORDINANCE 1990

**GIBRALTAR DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (EMPLOYER'S
INSOLVENCY) REGULATIONS 1991 (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 1999**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Government by section 26 of the Gibraltar Development Corporation Ordinance 1990, the Government has made the following regulations -

Title and commencement.

1.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Gibraltar Development Corporation (Employer's Insolvency) Regulations 1991 (Amendment) Regulations 1999.

(2) Regulation 2 shall come into force on the 1st July 1999, and, regulation 3 shall come into force on the 3rd January 2000.

Amendments to the Gibraltar Development Corporation (Employer's Insolvency) Regulations 1991.

2. The Gibraltar Development Corporation (Employer's Insolvency) Regulations 1991 shall be amended in regulation 6 as follows -

- (a) sub-regulation (1) shall be amended by substituting for the sum of "£26", the sum of "£18.20";
- (b) sub-regulation (2) shall be amended by substituting for references to "fifty pence" references to "thirty five pence."

Further amendments to the Gibraltar Development Corporation (Employer's Insolvency) Regulations 1991.

3. For regulation 6 of the Gibraltar Development Corporation (Employer's Insolvency) Regulations 1991 there shall be substituted the following regulation -

“Contributions to Fund.

6.(1) Every employer shall make a contribution of thirty five pence to the Fund in respect of a worker falling within these Regulations, commencing with the time in which he furnishes information in respect of that worker in accordance with regulation 11 of the Employment Regulations 1994 and then in respect of every complete week during which the employment continues.

(2) Contributions pursuant to subregulation (1) shall be paid together with the contributions payable in accordance with the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Ordinance by means of a single insurance stamp referred to in section 9 of that Ordinance.”.
