GIBRALTAR LAND TITLES ORDINANCE, 1990.

LAND TITLES (REGISTRATION) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1993.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 of the Gibraltar Land Titles Ordinance, 1990, I have made the following rules-

Title and commencement.

1. These rules may be cited as the Land Titles (Registration) (Amendment) Rules 1993 and shall come into effect on the 1st day of April 1993.

New rule 3.

2. The Land Titles (Registration) Rules 1991 are amended by inserting after rule 2 the following new rule-

"Form and copies of documents submitted for registration.

- 3.(1) Unless the nature of the documents shall render it impossible, any document submitted for registration, shall be-
 - (a) on papar of durable quality and of A4 size; and

(b) have on each page a margin of not less than 4 cms wide to be left blank on the left side of the face of the paper and on the right side of the reverse thereof.

(2) Any document submitted for registration, shall be accompanied by an unbound copy thereof (which copy may be a photocopy) and that copy shall be endorse by the person by whom it is submitted for registration as a true copy of the document submitted for registration and shall be retained by the Registrar. (3) Except in the case of an agreement to enter into a lease or assignment, a plan which forms part of a document submitted for registration, shall be -

(a) submitted with the document of which it forms part;

(b) accompanied by a tracing thereof on linen or on paper or other material approved by the Registrar, coloured like the original; and

(c) retained by the Registrar.

(4) In respect of a document executed prior to the 1st day of April 1993, the Registrar may, in his absolute discretion, accept a document which does not comply with the provisions of sub-rule (1)(b).".
