GIBRALTAR MERCHANT SHIPPING (SAFETY, ETC) ORDINANCE 1993

GIBRALTAR MERCHANT SHIPPING (MARINE EQUIPMENT) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 59 and 118 of the Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Safety, etc.) Ordinance, 1993 and all other enabling powers, the Government, for the purposes of transposing into the law of Gibraltar Commission Directive 2002/75/EC of 2 September 2002, and Article 5 of Directive 2002/84/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 November 2002 amending the Directives on maritime safety and prevention of pollution from ships, which amend Council Directive 96/98/EC on marine equipment, has made the following Regulations:

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Marine Equipment) (Amendment) Regulations 2004.

Amendment to regulation 2.

2. Regulation 2(1) of the Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Marine Equipment) Regulations 2002 is amended—

- (a) by inserting the following definition before the definition of “applicable international standards”:

““Annex A” means Annex A to the Directive in its up-to date version as in force at the time of reference;” and

- (b) in the definition of “Directive” by substituting “,Commission Directive 2001/53/EC, Commission Directive 2002/75/EC and Directive 2002/84/EC” for the words “and Commission Directive 2001/53/EC”.

Amendment to Schedule 1.

3. Schedule 1 to the Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Marine Equipment) Regulations, 2002 is amended as follows-

- (a) in the definition of “radiocommunications equipment”, the words and the date “in the version in force on 1 January 1999” are replaced by “ in its up-to-date version as in force at the time of reference”;
- (b) in the definition of “international conventions”, the words “ in force on date of adoption of this Directive” are replaced by “ in its up-to date version as in force at the time of reference”;
- (c) in the definition of “testing standards”, the words “ in force on date of adoption of this Directive” are replaced by “ in its up-to date version as in force at the time of reference,”.
