### **SCHEDULE**

*In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 86(a) of the Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Registration) Act, 1993 and section 118(1)(e) of the Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Safety, etc.) Act 1993, and of all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Regulations –*

**Title and commencement.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Fees, Charges and Taxes) Regulations 2009 and come into operation on 1 July 2009.

**Fees, Charges and Taxes.**

2.(1) The fees, charges and taxes shown in the Schedule shall be charged and payable in respect of the service shown.

(2) The Maritime Administrator may refuse to provide any service to a registered agent from whom any fees payable are outstanding or to a ship in respect of which any fees payable are outstanding.

**Revocations.**

3. The Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Ship Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 2005, (Legal Notice No. 87 of 2005), the Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Survey Fees and Charges) (Amendment) Regulations 2006 (Legal Notice No. 50 of 2006) and all Fee scales in Administrative Instructions under the Merchant Shipping (Safety, etc.) Act 1993 (Legal Notice. 2004/068) are revoked.

#### ANNUAL TONNAGE TAX

1. An annual tonnage tax shall be due and paid in respect of every ship registered, other than a ship plying in the Port of Gibraltar and licensed by the port authority as a harbour craft.
2. The annual tonnage tax shall be payable in advance before the first day of January of the year in respect of which it is due.
3. The annual tonnage tax shall be payable at the following rates—

#### Annual Tonnage Tax

<b>(1) Vessel – 4,000 GT</b>	increased to £800
(a) Annual Tonnage Tax (Full year, i.e. registered in January)	£1,080.00

(b) Annual Tonnage Tax (6 months i.e. registered in July)	£540.00

(c) Annual Tonnage Tax registered in November (includes ATT for the whole of the next year as well)[ATT requirements]	£1,260.00

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### (2) Vessel over 10,000 GT

(a) Annual Tonnage Tax (Full year, i.e. registered in January) £1,500.00

or

(b) Annual Tonnage Tax (6 months i.e. registered in July) £750.00

or

(c) Annual Tonnage Tax registered in November (includes ATT for the whole of the next year as well)[ATT requirements] £1,750.00

### (3) Vessel over 50,000 GT

Annual Tonnage Tax (Full year, i.e. registered in January) £4,300.00

or

Annual Tonnage Tax (6 months i.e. registered in July) £2,150.00

or

Annual Tonnage Tax registered in November (includes ATT for the whole of the next year as well)[ATT requirements] £5,016.67

### (4) Vessel over 120,000 GT

Annual Tonnage Tax (Full year, i.e. registered in January) £6,699.98

or

Annual Tonnage Tax (6 months i.e. registered in July) £3,349.99

or

Annual Tonnage Tax registered in November (includes ATT for the whole of the next year as well)[ATT requirements] £7,816.64

4. Where in the certificate or measurement of a ship more than one gross registered tonnage is specified, the annual tonnage tax shall be calculated by reference to the greatest of those tonnages.

5. When a ship is first registered after the 31st January in any year, the annual tonnage tax for that year shall be calculated at the rate of one twelfth of the rate of the full tonnage tax for that ship for each complete calendar month or proportion thereof of that year EXCEPT that if a ship is first registered during November or December in any year the tonnage tax

payable at that time shall be the tax calculated as aforesaid for that year plus the tax in respect of the next year.

6. The fees and tonnage tax payable and paid shall not be refundable.

### Survey, Audits and Inspection

Except where specifically provided in any Gibraltar Merchant shipping legislation for any fees or charges to be paid for the services of any surveyor appointed under section 52 of the Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Safety, etc.) Act, 1993, the Maritime Administrator shall charge fees in accordance with the table C below for carrying out surveys, audits or other inspections by a surveyor and a fee in accordance with the table C below for travel time taken to carry out such survey, audit or inspection.
