AN ORDINANCE to amend the Immigration Control Ordinance.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Immigration Control (Amendment) Ordinance, 1986.

Amendment of Section 12.

2. Section 12 of the Immigration Control Ordinance is amended by repealing sub-section (2) thereof, and substituting therefor the following new sub-section:-

"(2) Where the Governor is satisfied that any person who would, but for his inability to comply with the requirements of paragraphs

[4 of 1986]. Immigration Control (Amendment) Ordinance, 1986.

5(2)(c) or 7(c) of Schedule 1 to the British Nationality Act 1981, be otherwise eligible to apply for naturalisation as a British Dependent Territories Citizen under the provisions of section 18 of the British Nationality Act 1981 the Governor may, in his absolute discretion, by order exempt any such person from compliance with the requirements of subsection (1) of this section:

Provided that any order made under this subsection may be revoked by the Governor, acting in his absolute discretion, if:-

(a) the person exempted by such order fails to apply for naturalisation as a British Dependent Territories citizen under section 18 of the British Nationality Act, 1981 within 3 months of the date of the making of the order; or

(b) any such application for naturalisation as a British Dependent Territories Citizen under section 18 of the British Nationality Act 1981 is refused."
