**AN ORDINANCE** to amend the Immigration Control Ordinance.

**ENACTED** by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

**Title.**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Immigration Control Ordinance (Amendment) Ordinance 2001.

**Amendment to the Immigration Control Ordinance.**

2. The Immigration Control Ordinance shall be amended by substituting for section 11 the following section—

**“Entry into and Exit from Gibraltar.**

11. No person who seeks to enter or exit Gibraltar overland shall enter or exit other than—

- (a) through the pedestrian or vehicular gates at the frontier, or
- (b) through the commercial gates at the frontier at a time when it is open for authorised commercial traffic under the supervision and control of an immigration officer.”.
