AN ORDINANCE to amend the Immigration Control Ordinance further to the implementation into the law of Gibraltar of Council Directive 2001/55/EC of 20 July 2001 on minimum standards for giving temporary protection in the event of a mass influx of displaced persons and on measures promoting a balance of efforts between Member States in receiving such persons and bearing the consequences thereof.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Immigration Control (Temporary Protection) (Amendment)
Ordinance 2005 [No.19 of 2005]

Title and commencement.

1.(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Immigration Control (Temporary Protection) (Amendment) Ordinance 2005.

(2) This Ordinance comes into operation on the day appointed by the Government by notice in the Gazette and different days may be appointed for different purposes.

Amendment of the Immigration Control Ordinance.

2. After section 3 of the Immigration Control Ordinance insert—

“Persons enjoying temporary protection.

3A. The provisions of sections 6, 18(2) and (3), 20, 21, 23, 52, 53, and 54 shall not apply to persons enjoying temporary protection in Gibraltar under the Temporary Protection Ordinance 2005.”.
