IMMIGRATION, ASYLUM AND REFUGEE ACT

UKRAINE (TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS) (AMENDMENT) (No.10) REGULATIONS 2015

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 52A of the Immigration, Asylum and Refugee Act, and for the purposes of implementing Council Decision (CFSP) 2015/1524 of 14 September 2015 amending Decision 2014/145/CFSP concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine, the Minister has made the following Regulations—

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Ukraine (Travel Restrictions) (Amendment) (No. 10) Regulations 2015.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment to the Ukraine (Travel Restrictions) Regulations 2014.

3. The Ukraine (Travel Restrictions) Regulations 2014 is amended in accordance with the provisions of regulations 4 and 5 of these Regulations.

Amendment to Article 6.

4. In Article 6, the second paragraph is replaced with the following-

"This Decision shall apply until 15 March 2016.".

Amendment to the Annex.

5. The Annex (which reproduces Council Decision 2014/145/CFSP) is amended as follows-

- (a) the entry set out in the Annex concerning "Oleksiy Borisovych MOZGOVY" is deleted;
- (b) the entries set out in the Annex concerning the persons listed below are replaced with the following entries-
