**AN ORDINANCE** to amend the Imports and Exports Ordinance 1986.

**ENACTED** by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

**Short title.**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Imports and Exports (Amendment) Ordinance, 1989.

**Amendment of section 73.**

2. Section 73 of the Imports and Exports Ordinance 1986 is amended by repealing sub-section (1) and substituting therefor the following subsection-

*Imports and Exports (Amendment) Ordinance, 1989. [No. 3 of 1989.]*

"(1) The Financial and Development Secretary may by order declare any premises from which articles of any description specified in the order (hereinafter called "duty free goods") on which duty has not been paid may be sold to any person who is about to leave Gibraltar."
