**An Ordinance** to amend the imports and Exports Ordinance.

**ENACTED** by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

**Title.**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Imports and Exports (Amendment) Ordinance 1989.

**Amendment to section 2.**

2. Section 2 of the Imports and Exports Ordinance 1986 (hereinafter called "the principal Ordinance") is amended in subsection ( 1 ) by inserting after the definition of "trailer" the following definition-

"transit or transshipment" in relation to entry of goods, means transit through Gibraltar or transshipment with a view to the re-exportation of the goods in question."

**Repeal and replacement of section 63.**

3. The principal Ordinance is amended by repealing section 63 and substituting therefor the following section-

"Exemption from duty on goods in transit etc.

63. Where any goods are entered for transit or transshipment, the Collector may allow the goods to be removed for that purpose, subject to such conditions and restrictions as he may see fit, without payment of duty."
