AN ORDINANCE to amend the Imports and Exports Ordinance
1986.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Imports and Exports (Amendment) Ordinance 2004 and comes into operation on the day appointed by the Government by notice in the Gazette.

Amendment to the Imports and Exports Ordinance 1986.

2. The Imports and Exports Ordinance is amended by inserting after section 9—

“Customs officers may be armed.

9A. A customs officer, when engaged in the performance of any duty or the exercise of any power imposed or conferred on him by or under this or any other Ordinance, may, if specifically authorised by the Collector of Customs with the written consent of the Chief Secretary, be armed with a truncheon.”.
