IMPORTS AND EXPORTS ORDINANCE, 1986.

**IMPORTS AND EXPORTS (CONTROL) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1989.**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 16 and 129 of the Imports and Exports Ordinance, 1986 and of all other enabling powers the Governor has made the following regulations

Title.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Imports and Exports (Control) (Amendment) Regulations, 1989.

Amendment of the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations, 1987.

2. Schedule 1 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations 1987 is amended by adding the following paragraph-

"12. Raw and worked ivory derived from the African elephant (*Loxodonia africana*);

Provided that-

- (a) musical instruments containing parts made of ivory which is proven to have been re-exported from the European Economic Community;
- (b) antiques;
- (c) hunting trophies which are proven to have resulted from the exercise of a hunting permit issued with a view to enhancing the survival of the population in question;
- (d) personal effects and household goods (not including tourist souvenirs) accompanied by an export permit from the country

of origin where that country requires the issue of such a document for the export of worked ivory,

may be imported if prior permission has been obtained from the Collector of Customs."
