IMPORTS AND EXPORTS ACT, 1986

IMPORTS AND EXPORTS (CONTROL) (AMENDMENT NO.2) REGULATIONS 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 16 of the Imports and Exports Act, 1986 the Government has made these Regulations-

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Imports and Exports (Control) (Amendment No.2) Regulations 2022.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment of regulations.

3. The Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations, 1987 are amended by substituting the following paragraph for paragraph 21 of Schedule 1-

“21. A test (in whichever form and including samples) that may be used for the purpose of determining the presence of the coronavirus COVID-19 also referred to as SARS-CoV-2 unless that test-

(a) appears on a list of approved tests that is maintained by the Director of Public Health; or

(b) is approved in writing by the Civil Contingencies Coordinator.

In this paragraph “Civil Contingencies Coordinator” means the person appointed under section 19 of the Civil Contingencies Act 2007.”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations provide for the restriction on the importation of tests for coronavirus COVID-19 also referred to as SARS-CoV-2.

Tests may not be imported unless they appear on a list of approved tests that is to be maintained by the Director of Public Health or if approved in writing by the Civil Contingencies Coordinator.
