IMPORTS AND EXPORTS ACT, 1986

IMPORTS AND EXPORTS (CONTROL) (AMENDMENT No.2) REGULATIONS 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 16 of the Imports and Exports Act, 1986, and all other enabling powers, the Government has made these Regulations-

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Imports and Exports (Control) (Amendment No.2) Regulations 2023.

Commencement.

2. Regulation 3(1) comes into operation on the day of publication and Regulation 3(2) comes into operation on the 1 July 2023.

Amendment to the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations, 1987.

3. Schedule 1 to the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations, 1987 is amended-

(1) in paragraph 24-

(a) by inserting the following proviso after paragraph 24(1)-

“Provided the Collector may permit the importation of such motor vehicles up to and including 30 June 2023, where the Collector is satisfied the importer was unable to finalise arrangements for importation prior to 1 January 2023 and the importer has provided all information the Collector requires to enable him to come to a decision.” and

(b) by substituting paragraph 24(3) with the following-

“(3) This paragraph shall not apply to –

(a) classic motor vehicles as defined in the Traffic (Licensing and Registration) Regulations;

(b) zero emissions motor vehicles;

- (c) motor vehicles imported by such category of persons prescribed by the Collector in consultation with the Minister for the Environment and subject to such conditions (if any) prescribed in writing; or
- (d) motor vehicles imported under a customs temporary basis regime.”

(2) after paragraph 25 insert-

“26.(1) Mopeds imported into Gibraltar fully fuelled by diesel or petrol.

- (2) For the purposes of this paragraph, “mopeds” means a motorcycle which has an engine with a cubic capacity of not more than 50cc.” .

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations give effect to 2022 Chief Minister Budget Measures to prohibit the importation of mopeds fully fuelled by diesel or petrol and amends the prohibition of imported motor vehicles over 5 years old from the date of manufacture.
