IMPORTS AND EXPORTS ORDINANCE

EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1999

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 79 of the Imports and Exports Ordinance and all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations –

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) Regulations (Amendment) Regulations 1999.

Amendment to the Schedule to the Export of Goods (Control) Regulations.

2. The Schedule to the Export of Goods (Control) Regulations 1997 shall be amended by –

- (a) the insertion of the words “Part I” immediately above the heading “MILITARY, SECURITY AND PARA-MILITARY GOODS AND ARMS, AMMUNITION AND RELATED MATERIAL”;
- (b) the substitution of the word “Schedule” wherever it appears in the “General Note” in the new Part I by the word “Part”;
- (c) the insertion of a new Part II as follows:

“PART II

AIR TRANSPORT OF DANGEROUS GOODS

Classification and list of dangerous goods

1. Any article or substance which is capable of posing significant risk to health, safety or property when

carried by air and which is classified and listed in the Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air approved and published by decision of the Council of the International Civil Aviation Organisation for the time being in force, to the extent that Part I of this Schedule does not already make provision for such articles or substances.”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations extend the scope of the controls imposed by the principal Regulations to the export of certain articles and substances listed by ICAO as dangerous goods when transported by air.
