**ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS**

*In exercise of the powers conferred by section 73(1) of the Imports and Exports Act, 1986, the Collector of Customs has made the following Order-*

**Title.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Designation of Premises Order 2023.

**Commencement.**

2. The Order shall come into operation on the day of publication.

**Designation of premises.**

3 Subject to paragraph 3A below, the Collector has designated any cruise ship moored at or within the Port, as premises at which goods on which duty has not been paid may be sold to passengers on that ship.

3A.(1) Intoxicating beverages may only be sold at any time from a cruise ship's bar or restaurant for consumption by passengers whilst the ship is moored at or within the Port.

(2) All other goods, not being intoxicating beverages sold from a cruise ship's bar or restaurant, may only be sold to passengers on a cruise ship moored at or within the Port after 6pm and which is expected to depart within the following 12 hours.

**Revocation.**

4. The Designation of Premises Order (LN 2011/092) is revoked.
