AN ORDINANCE to amend the Insurance (Motor Vehicles) (Third Party Risks) Ordinance in connection with the accession of the Czech Republic, the Republic of Hungary, and the Slovak Republic to the European Union.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement.

Insurance (Motor Vehicles) (Third Party Risks) (Amendment) (EU Accession Countries) Ordinance 2004 [No. 28 of 2004]

1.(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Insurance (Motor Vehicles) (Third Party Risks) (Amendment) (EU Accession Countries) Ordinance 2004.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 May 2004.

Amendment of the Insurance (Motor Vehicles) (Third Party Risks) Ordinance 1986.

2. Section 2(1) of the Insurance (Motor Vehicles) (Third Party Risks) Ordinance 1986 is amended by deleting from the definition of “relevant foreign state” the words “Czechoslovakia” and “Hungary”.
