AN ORDINANCE to amend the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance to include a definition of the Agreement on the European Economic Area.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Interpretation and General Clauses (Amendment) Ordinance 2004
[No. 22 of 2004]

Title and commencement.

1.(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Interpretation and General Clauses (Amendment) Ordinance 2004.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 May 2004.

Amendment of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance.

2. The Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance is amended by inserting the following new section after section 5–

“References to European Economic Area Agreement

5A. Any reference in any Ordinance to the European Economic Area Agreement shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as referring to the European Economic Area Agreement signed in Oporto on 2 May 1992 as adjusted by the Protocol signed at Brussels on 17 March 1993 and as amended or adjusted from time to time.”
