**LICENSING AND FEES ACT.**

**LICENSING AND FEES (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE) NOTICE,  
1986.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 52 of the Licensing and Fees Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor with the prior approval of the House of Assembly has issued the following notice:

**Title.**

1. This notice may be cited as the Licensing and Fees (Amendment of Schedule Notice, 1986.

**Amendment of Item 3 of Schedule 2.**

2. Schedule 2 to the Licensing and Fees Act is amended by revoking paragraph 1 of Item 3 thereof and substituting therefor the following:

“1.	Matter in which fee may be taken	Amount of fee £	To whom fee is payable.
(a)	Registration of a person as a British citizen under section 5 of the British Nationality Act, 1981.	5	Into the Consolidated Fund.
(b)	Registration of a person of full age as a British Dependent Territories citizen under the British Nationality Act, 1981.	60	The same.
(c)	Registration of a minor as a British Dependent Territories citizen under the British Nationality Act, 1981, except under section 21.	60	The same.
(d)	Registration of a minor as		

	a British Dependent Territories citizen under section 21 of the British Nationality Act, 1981.	10	The same.
(e)	Grant of a Certificate of Naturalisation as a British Dependent Territories citizen under Section 18(1) of the British Nationality Act, 1981.	170	The same.
(f)	Grant of a Certificate of Naturalisation as a British Dependent Territories citizen under Section 18(2) of the British Nationality Act, 1981.	60	The same.
(g)	Registration of a declaration of renunciation of British Dependent Territories citizenship under Section 24 of the British Nationality Act, 1981.	10	The same.
(h)	Supplying a certified or other copy of a notice, certificate, order, declaration or entry given, granted or made under the British Nationality Act, 1981 or any of the former nationality Acts.	10	The same.

(i)	Administering the oath of allegiance for the purposes of the British Nationality Act, 1981.	2	If the oath is administered by a Commissioner for Oaths or Notary Public, to the Commissioner for Oaths or Notary Public."
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**Amendment of Item 5 of Schedule 2.**

3. Schedule 2 to the Licensing and Fees Act is further amended by revoking paragraph (i) of item 5, and substituting therefor the following new paragraphs:

“(k) Making or forwarding, or both, a request or recommendation to or issuing any certificate, declaration, or document which may be required by, an authority of Her Majesty’s Government in the United Kingdom, a dependency of the United Kingdom, or any other country or territory for or in connection with the application for, issue or renewal of:

(a)(i) entry clearance (other than for the United Kingdom or a dependency of The United Kingdom).....	£ 6.00
(b) a residence permit, identity card, application for registration or naturalisation or any other certificate or document (except a Home Office travel document) .....	4.50

in addition to the fees payable for such documents under the Immigration Control Act, the Civilians Registration Act and Item 3 of this Schedule:

(1)(a) Receiving an application for an entry clearance.....	25.00
unless	

(b) the applicant seeks entry as a visitor, student, passenger in transit, "au pair" or for a working holiday, in which case, if the application is granted, the fee is ..... 12.00  
or, if granted for multiple entries ..... 24.00

or, for any application or entry clearance, such sums, being the equivalents of fees charged by the authorities of any State for receiving or granting an application for an entry clearance to a British Citizen, as the Secretary of State, with the consent of the Treasury, directs to be taken for receiving or granting an application for an entry clearance from a national or citizen of that State

in addition to fee (k) where applicable."
