LICENSING AND FEES (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE) NOTICE 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 40 of the Licensing and Fees Act, and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Notice—

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Licensing and Fees (Amendment of Schedule) Notice 2019.

Commencement.

- 2.(1) Subject to subparagraph (2), this Notice is deemed to have come into operation on 2 July 2018.
- (2) Paragraph 4 comes into operation on 1 September 2019.

Amendment of the Licensing and Fees Act.

3. The Schedule to the Licensing and Fees Act is amended by substituting the entry with the heading "1. CUSTOMS CERTIFICATES" in its entirety with the following-

"

1. CUSTOMS

- (a) For any certificate issued by the Collector of Customs in relation to quantities and condition of any class of goods imported into or exported from Gibraltar:—
 - (i) certificate of landing or shipment;
 - (ii) certificate of weight or measurement (applicable also to liquors);
 - (iii) certificate of examination of goods, short or damaged;
- (b) Declaration of import of a motor vehicle for personal use.

4. The Schedule to the Licensing and Fees Act is amended in the entry with the heading "1. **CUSTOMS**" by inserting the following paragraphs after paragraph (b)-

"

- (c) Issue of an import licence under the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations, 1987;
- (d) Issue of an export licence under the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations, 1987;
- (e) Declaration of goods imported on a temporary basis;
- (f) Declaration of goods in transit;
- (g) Transfer or assignment of an import licence granted in respect of a vessel or caravan (as defined by paragraph 5 of Schedule 1 to the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations, 1987.
