**LICENSING AND FEES ACT**

**LICENCE (FEES) RULES 1991 (AMENDMENT) RULES 2000**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 51 of the Licensing and Fees Act the Governor has made the following Rules—

**Citation.**

1. These Rules may be cited as the Licence (Fees) Rules 1991 (Amendment) Rules 2000.

**Amendment to the Licence (Fees) Rules 1991.**

2. The Licence (Fees) Rules 1991 shall be amended in paragraph 4 (Office Fees) of Schedule 2 by substituting for the words “The sum specified in the right-hand columns are to be paid by means of revenue stamps affixed to the document and cancelled by the officer issuing or signing the same.” the following words—

“The sum specified in the right-hand columns may be paid in cash, cheque drawn on a British or Gibraltar bank or by means of revenue stamps. Where the sum is paid in cash or cheque, the fact shall be recorded on the document and signed by the public officer, justice of the peace or notary public. Where the sum is paid by means of revenue stamps, the stamps shall be affixed to the document and cancelled by the officer issuing or signing the same.”.
