## LICENSING AND FEES ACT

### LICENSING (AMENDMENT) RULES 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 51 of the Licensing and Fees Act, the Governor has made the following rules—

#### **Title and commencement.**

1. These rules may be cited as the Licensing (Amendment) Rules 2004 and come into operation on 1 January 2005.

#### **Amendments to Schedule 2 to the Licensing Rules.**

2.(1) Paragraph 3 of Schedule 2 to the Licensing Rules is amended as follows—

- (a) sub-paragraph (b) is amended by substituting for the word “Dependent” the word “Overseas” and by substituting for the figures “£120.00” the figures “£85.00”;
- (b) sub-paragraph (c) is amended by substituting for the word “Dependent” the word “Overseas” and by substituting for the figures “£120.00” the figures “£144.00”;
- (c) sub-paragraph (d) is amended by substituting for the word “Dependent” the word “Overseas”;
- (d) sub-paragraph (e) is amended by substituting for the word “Dependent” the word “Overseas” and by substituting for the figures “£120.00” the figures “£146.00”.
- (a) sub-paragraph (f) is amended by substituting for the word “Dependent” the word “Overseas” and by substituting for the figures “£20.00” the figures “£81.00”.

(2) Paragraph 5 of Schedule 2 to the Licensing Rules is amended as follows–

- (a) sub-paragraph a (i) and (ii) are amended by substituting for the figures “£33.00” and “£19.00”, the figures “£42.00” and “£25.00” respectively;
- (b) sub-paragraph (d) and sub-paragraph (e) are revoked.
- (c) sub-paragraph (g) is amended by substituting for the figures “10.00” the figures “£13.00” and by adding the words “No fee shall be taken in respect of these services if the applicant is born on or before 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 1929”.
- (d) at the end of the Note after paragraph (i) after the word Gibraltar by adding the words” or to a British National born on or before 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 1929.”
- (e) sub-paragraph (k) is replaced by the following–
