LICENSING AND FEES ACT

LICENSING AND FEES (MANUFACTURING OF SPIRITS) (AMENDMENT) RULES 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 51 of the Licensing and Fees Act and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules -

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Licensing and Fees (Manufacturing of Spirits) (Amendment) Rules 1995.

Amendment to Schedule.

2. The Schedule to the Licensing and Fees (Manufacturing of Spirits) Rules 1995 is amended -

(a) by inserting before paragraph 1 the paragraph heading-

“Wines”;

(b) by inserting after paragraph 2 the following new paragraphs -

“Spirits.

3. The prescribed strength and type of spirit permitted under the manufacturer's licence issued to the Old Gibraltar Spirit Company Limited is spirits of not more than 40% and may include gin, vodka, brandy and anisette.

4. The prescribed quantity of spirits of all types permitted under the manufacturer's licence specified in paragraph 3 is not more than 30,000 bottles containing one litre per calendar month:

Provided that with the consent of the Collector of Customs given in writing in advance (which consent may be given no more than twice in any period of twelve months) the number of bottles produced per month may, for a period of no more than two consecutive months, be increased to the number specified by the Collector of Customs.”.
