AN ORDINANCE to amend the Matrimonial Causes Ordinance to make provision for Council Regulation (EC) No 2201/2003 of 27 November 2003 concerning jurisdiction and the recognition and enforcement of judgments in matrimonial matters and the matters of parental responsibility, repealing Regulation (EC) No 1347/2000 and for Council Regulation (EC) No 22/2001 of 22 December 2000 on jurisdiction and the recognition and enforcement of judgments in civil and commercial matters.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Matrimonial Causes (Amendment) Ordinance 2005.

Amendment to the Matrimonial Causes Ordinance

2. The Matrimonial Causes Ordinance is amended by–

(a) inserting the following after section 60–

**“PART X
JURISDICTION, AND RECOGNITION AND ENFORCEMENT OF
JUDGMENTS MADE IN A MEMBER STATE OF THE EUROPEAN
UNION.**

Jurisdiction, and recognition and enforcement of judgments made in a member state of the European Union.

60A. This Ordinance shall have effect subject to–

- (a) Council Regulation (EC) No 2201/2003 of 27 November 2003 concerning jurisdiction and the recognition and enforcement of judgments in matrimonial matters and the matters of parental responsibility, repealing Regulation (EC) No 1347/2000 and to section 38A of the Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Ordinance 1993;
- (b) Council Regulation (EC) No 22/2001 of 22 December 2000 on jurisdiction and the recognition and enforcement of judgments in civil and commercial matters and sections 38 and 39 of the Civil Jurisdiction and Judgments Ordinance 1993.”

(b) renumbering the existing Part X as Part XI.
