MEDICAL (GROUP PRACTICE SCHEME) ORDINANCE.

MEDICAL (GROUP PRACTICE SCHEME) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1989.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 10 of the Medical (Group Practice Scheme) Ordinance, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations:

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Medical (Group Practice Scheme) (Amendment) Regulations, 1989.

New Regulation.

2. The medical (Group Practice Scheme) Regulations (hereinafter called "the principal regulations") are amended by inserting after regulation 8 the following new regulation –

"Dental treatment.

- 8A. (1) Full dental treatment shall be provided free of charge to
- (a) persons entitled to medical attention and treatment under the District Medical Scheme,
- (b) persons exempt from the payment of the annual and registration fees under regulation 6A,
- (c) persons confined in a prison,
- (2) Emergency dental treatment and oral surgery shall be provided free of charge to any person on whose behalf payments are made for the time being from the Social Assistance Fund as provided 59

- in regulation 4(2)(a) of the Social Assistance Fund (Establishment) Notice, 1988.
- (3) Emergency dental treatment shall be provided to persons registered as members (other than persons referred to in subregulation (1) or (2)) on payment of a fee of f4 for each visit.".

Amendment to regulation 11.

3. Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is revoked and the following regulation is substituted therefor-

"Supply of medicines.

11.(1) Medicines shall be supplied by the Scheme pharmacists to any entitled person on any prescriptions issued to him by a doctor under the Scheme on payment of £1.20 for each item on such prescription;

Provided that

except as provided in proviso (ii) below, such medicines shall be supplied free of charge to any person entitled to medical attention and treatment under the District Medical Scheme and to any person exempt from the payment of the annual and registration fees under regulation 6A, and

in the case of a person on whose behalf payments are made for the time being from the Social Assistance Fund as provided in regulation 4 (2) (a) of the Social Assistance Fund (Establishment) Notice, 1988, such medicines shall be supplied on payment of 20 pence for each item.

(2) in this regulation "Scheme pharmacist" means a person who has entered into an agreement with the Government or with the Gibraltar Health 60

Authority to supply prescriptions under the Scheme.".

Amendment to Schedule.

4. Schedule 3 to the principal regulations is amended by substituting £2 and £5 for 50p and £1 respectively.
