**MEDICAL (GROUP PRACTICE SCHEME) ORDINANCE**

**MEDICAL (GROUP PRACTICE SCHEME) REGULATIONS  
(AMENDMENT) (No. 2) REGULATIONS, 1998**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 10 of the Medical (Group Practice Scheme) Ordinance, the Governor has made the following Regulations -

**Title.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Medical (Group Practice Scheme) Regulations (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1998.

**Amendment to the Medical (Group Practice Scheme) Regulations.**

2. For Schedule 3 to the Medical (Group Practice Scheme) Regulations there shall be substituted the following Schedule -

**“SCHEDULE 3**

Regulation 8(2)

**FEES**

The following fees shall be paid by entitled persons other than persons exempted from the payment of fees under the provisions of regulation 8(3).

For each house visit for a doctor -

1. in respect of a person in receipt of a retirement pension under the Social Security (Non-Contributory Benefits) Ordinance, the Social Security (Open Long Term Benefits Scheme)

2. in respect of any person to which paragraph 1 above  
does not apply £10.”.
