**MEDICAL (GROUP PRACTICE SCHEME) ORDINANCE**

**MEDICAL (GROUP PRACTICE SCHEME) (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS 2005**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 10 of the Medical (Group Practice Scheme) Ordinance the Governor has made the following Regulations—

**Title and commencement.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Medical (Group Practice Scheme) (Amendment) Regulations 2005 and shall be deemed to have come into force on 1 July 2005.

**Amendment of the Medical (Group Practice Scheme) Regulations.**

2. The Medical (Group Practice Scheme) Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 3 the following regulation—

**“Free driving licence health examination for persons who have attained 70 years or over.**

3A. A person who has attained the age of 70 years shall be entitled to receive an examination referred to in regulation 73(1) of the Traffic (Licensing and Registration) Regulations free of any charge.”.
