NATURE PROTECTION ACT

NATURE PROTECTION (UPPER ROCK NATURE RESERVE FEES) (AMENDMENT) NOTICE 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 23 of the Nature Protection Act 1991, the Minister has made the following Notice –

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Nature Protection (Upper Rock Nature Reserve Fees) (Amendment) Notice 2020.

Commencement.

2. This Notice comes into operation on 1 April 2020.

Amendment to the Nature Protection Act 1991.

3.(1) The Nature Protection Act 1991 is amended in accordance with this paragraph.

(2) In Schedule 10, paragraph 1-

(a) for subparagraph (1)(a) substitute-

“(a) £13.00 per person aged 12 years or over entering by foot at Jews’ Gate (Engineer Road and Lathbury Barracks), Willis’s Road, Devil’s Gap Battery or any cable car station;”;

(b) after subparagraph (1)(a) insert-

“(aa) £8.00 per person aged from 5 to 11 years inclusive entering by foot at Jews’ Gate (Engineer Road and Lathbury Barracks), Willis’s Road, Devil’s Gap Battery or any cable car station;”;

(c) delete subparagraphs (1)(e) and (f);

(d) in subparagraph (1)(g), for “£5.00 per person aged 5 years or over” substitute “£13.00 per person aged 12 years or over”; and

(e) in subparagraph (1)(h), for “aged 5 years or over entering with a bicycle as part of a tour group with a tour operator via Jews’ Gate” substitute “aged 5 to 11 years inclusive entering with a bicycle via Jews’ Gate”.

(f) in subparagraph (2)(a) substitute-

“(a) £13.00 for each person aged 12 years and over who entered the Upper Rock Nature Reserve by foot at Jews’ Gate, Willis’s Road, Devil’s Gap Battery or any cable car station (applicable to all tourist sites with the exception of lower St Michael’s Cave);”;

(g) in subparagraph (2)(b) substitute-

“(b) £8.00 for each child aged from 5 to 11 years inclusive who entered the Upper Rock Nature Reserve by foot at Jews’ Gate, Willis’s Road, Devil’s Gap Battery or any cable car station (applicable to all tourist sites with the exception of lower St Michael’s Cave);”; and

(h) in subparagraph (2)(d) substitute-

“(d) £4.00 for each person entering the World War II Tunnels holding a valid Gibraltar identity card or MOD identity document.”; and

(i) in subparagraph (4) for the words “The fees set out in subparagraphs (1)(b) and (c) shall be reduced”, substitute “The fees set out in subparagraphs (1)(a) to (h) shall be reduced”.

(3) In Schedule 10, paragraph 2-

(a) in subparagraph(1), for the words “and (d)(iii) respectively” substitute “and (d) respectively”; and

(b) in subparagraph (3), delete the words “(d) and shall for the purposes of paragraph 1(2) be deemed to have entered the Upper Rock Nature Reserve by foot at Jew’s gate or Moorish Castle”.
