**HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY ORDINANCE.**

**ELECTORS (REGISTRATION) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1986.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 25 of the House of Assembly Ordinance, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules:

**Title.**

1. These rules may be cited as the Electors (Registration) (Amendment) Rules, 1986.

**Replacement of Schedule.**

2. The Electors (Registration) Rules are amended by revoking the Schedule thereto, and substituting therefor the following new Schedule:

**NOTICE AS TO PUBLICATION OF THE ELECTORS LIST AND  
MAKING OF CLAIMS AND OBJECTIONS.**

**HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY ORDINANCE.**

I hereby give notice that the Electors List for the new Register/ Supplement to the ..... Register of Electors is now available for inspection at my office and at ..... Claims and objections in respect of the list must be received by me at the address below on or before ..... an objection to a claim may be made within three days after the claim has been made.

Every claim or objection must be made in the prescribed form. Forms may be obtained from me at the address below.

A claim to be registered as an elector may be made by any person either on his own behalf or on behalf of another person. The person for whom the claim is made must be a British citizen, British Dependent Territories citizen, British Overseas citizen or British subject under the British Nationality Act 1981, must have the qualifications specified in section 3 of the House of Assembly Ordinance, and must be aged eighteen or more on the (day up to which a person is entitled to be included in the register).

Lists of claims and objections will be available for inspection at my office.

An objection to another person's registration as an elector can only be made by a person who, according to the electors list, is himself entitled to be registered.

NOTE 5. As this return is normally made before the qualifying date remember to include anyone who is expected to qualify by that date.

NOTE 6. A person who is a member of Her Majesty's Forces or who is the wife of such person should not be included; but a member of the Gibraltar Regiment should be included, as also his wife, provided they are otherwise qualified to be registered as electors. "
