ELECTORS (REGISTRATION) RULES (AMENDMENT) RULES 1999

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 25 of the House of Assembly Ordinance, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following Rules -

Title.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Electors (Registration) Rules (Amendment) Rules 1999.

Amendments to the Electors (Registration) Rules.

2. The Schedule to the Electors (Registration) Rules shall be amended by omitting Form RD therein and substituting therefor the following new Form RD -

NOTE 1. On application being made to the Clerks employed in distributing and collecting the forms or to the Electoral Registration Officer you will be given any help needed in filling up the form.

NOTE 2. When deciding whom you should include in this return **do not forget** to include yourself if qualified to be registered as an elector. You should also include those persons who may have been or may be temporarily absent, ie. as a student, on holiday, on a visit or in hospital during the 6 months ending on the......

You should include all those who are British citizens, British Dependent Territories citizen, British Overseas citizens, or British Subjects under the British Nationality Act 1981, qualified to be registered as electors whether they are members of your family or not.

- NOTE 3. The following presumptions will apply in determining whether a person intends to live in Gibraltar either permanently or indefinitely:
 - (a) where a person has his/her home in Gibraltar, he/she shall be presumed to intend to live in Gibraltar permanently or indefinitely;
 - (b) where a person has more than one home, he/she shall be presumed to live permanently or indefinitely in that place in which he/she has his/her principal home;

(c) where a person is stationed in Gibraltar for the principal purpose of carrying on a business, profession or occupation, and his wife and children, if any, have their home outside Gibraltar, he shall be presumed to intend to live permanently or indefinitely in the latter place.

NOTE 4. A person who attains the age of 18 between the.....and the.....and is otherwise qualified will be entitled to be included in the register and to vote at any election which takes place after he/she has attained the age of eighteen years.

NOTE 5. As this return is normally made **before the qualifying date** remember to include anyone who is expected to qualify by that date.

NOTE 6. A person who is a member of Her Majesty's Forces or who is the wife of such person should not be included; but a member of the Gibraltar Regiment should be included, as also his wife, **provided they are otherwise qualified to be registered as electors.**".
