**HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY ORDINANCE.**

**POSTAL VOTING (PROCEDURE) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1987.**

In exercise of his powers under section 25 of the House of Assembly Ordinance and all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules-

**Title.**

1. These rules may be cited as the Postal Voting (Procedure) (Amendment) Rules, 1987.

**Amendment to rule 5.**

2. Rule 5 of the Postal Voting (Procedure) Rules (hereinafter called "the principal rules") is amended:

- (a) by revoking sub-rules (1) and (2) and substituting therefor the following sub-rule-

"(1) the provisions of this rule apply in relation to applications for registration in the list of postal voters made in pursuance of the provisions of rule 34 of the Election Rules. ",

- (b) by revoking sub-rule (5).

**Amendment to Schedule.**

3. The Schedule to the principal rules is amended by omitting Forms I and II and substituting therefor the following Form-
