PENSIONS ACT.

PENSIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1986.

Title and commencement.

1.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Regulations, 1986.

(2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1984.

Amendment of Pensions Regulations.

2. Regulation 5 of the Pensions Regulations is amended –

(a) by revoking sub-regulation (2) and substituting the following-

"(2) This regulation applies to any officer who has been in public service under the Government continuously for not less than ten years and who -

(a) has attained the age of sixty years or, in special cases approved by the Governor, fifty-five years; or

(b) is discharged on the ground of redundancy; or

(c) is retired on medical evidence to the satisfaction of the Governor that he is incapable by reason of some infirmity of mind or body of discharging the duties of his office and that such infirmity is likely to be permanent."; and

(b) by deleting from sub-regulation (3) the reference to sub-regulation (2)(b) and substituting a reference to sub-regulation (2)(c).
