LEGAL NOTICE NO. 13 OF 1989.

**PENSIONS ACT.**

**PENSIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1989.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 3 of the Pensions Act and with the sanction of the Secretary of State, the Governor has made the following regulations.

**Title.**

1. These regulations may be cited as Pensions (Amendment) Regulations, 1989.

**New regulation.**

2. The Pensions Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 23 the following new regulation, namely-

"Officers between 55 and 60 years of age.

23A. If an officer holding a pensionable office retires in the circumstances mentioned in regulation 23 after he attains the age of 55 years but before he attains the age of 60 years-

(a) the provisions of regulation 23 shall not have effect, and

(b) the period between the date of his retirement and the notional date of his sixtieth birthday shall be added to the period of his pensionable service."
