PENSIONS ACT.

PENSIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1992.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the Pensions Act, I have made the following regulations-

Title and commencement.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Regulations 1992 and shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 26th day of April 1990.

Amendment to regulation 19.

- 2. Regulation 19 of the Pensions Regulations is amended-
 - (a) in sub-regulation (1) by-
 - (i) omitting the fullstop at the end of paragraph (ii) of the proviso to sub-regulation (1) (c) (ii) and substituting therefor a colon;
 - (ii) inserting at the end of the proviso to paragraph (c) a proviso to the sub-regulation as follows-

"Provided that in respect of the Sunday duty allowance for officers in the postal services, the amount to be taken into account for the purposes of computing the amount of the pension or gratuity, there shall be taken into account the best consecutive twelve mouths' earnings of Sunday duty allowance during the period of three years preceding the date of his retirement.";

(b) in sub-regulation (3) by omitting the semi-colon at the end of paragraph (a) and substituting therefor a colon and the following proviso-

"Provided that the proviso to sub-regulation (1) in respect of Sunday duty allowauce for officers in the postal services, shall be taken into account;".
