Pensions (Amendment) Regulations 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3 of the Pensions Act, and all other enabling powers, and after approval by resolution of the Parliament, the Government has made the following Regulations—

Title and application.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Regulations 2007 and shall be applied from 1 January 2001.

Pensions for non-pensionable officers.

2. Non-pensionable officers under the Pensions Act shall, for the purpose of retirement on medical grounds, death in service and retirement as a consequence of injury at work or as a result of contracting a disease in the discharge of their duties, have the right to be treated as if he or she were an officer in a pensionable office and receive the same pension and gratuity as an officer in a pensionable office with the same amount of pensionable service. No service below the age of 18 shall be treated as pensionable service.

Consequential matters.

3. For the purposes of calculating the annual equivalent salary of a weekly wage for the purposes of the calculation of a pension in a pensionable office, the weekly wage shall be multiplied by 52.1784503.

Revocation.

4. The Pensions (Amendment) Regulations 2002 are revoked.
