PETROLEUM ORDINANCE.

PETROLEUM (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1991.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 7 of the Petroleum Ordinance, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Petroleum (Amendment) Rules, 1991.

Amendment to heading.

2. The heading to Part 1 of the Petroleum Rules (hereinafter called "the principal Rules") is amended by inserting after the word "LIGHTERS" the words "AND OTHER SHIPS"

Amendment to sub-heading.

3. The sub-heading appearing immediately before rule 11 of the principal

Rules is amended by omitting the words "Lighter and Hulks" and substituting therefor the words "Hulks, Lighters and other Ships".

Amendment to rule 12

- 4. Rule 12 of the principal Rules is amended by—
 - (a) inserting after the figure "12" the figures "(1)";
 - (b) inserting a new sub-rule as follows—
 - "(2) No ship to ship transfer of petroleum spirit shall take place except with the prior consent obtained in writing of the Captain of the Port and subject to any conditions imposed by him.".

Amendment to rule 20.

5. Rule 20 of the principal Rules is amended by—
