**PORT ORDINANCE**

**PORT (AMENDMENT) RULES 2005**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 19 of the Port Ordinance, the Governor has made the following Rules—

**Title and commencement.**

1. These Rules may be cited as the Port (Amendment) Rules 2005 and come into operation on 1 April 2005.

**Amendment of the Port Rules.**

2. The Port Rules are amended in Schedule 4 as follows—

- (a) heading 3 (Boat, lighter and pontoon licences for use within the port) is amended in the entry “For a pleasure boat over 10 feet in length (excluding surf boards and sail boats)” by substituting for the corresponding fee of “£10”, “£20”;
- (b) the following heading is inserted after heading 6 (bunkering charges -

**“7. Miscellaneous charges.**

Rental of a structure commonly known as a portacabin	£2.40 per sq.ft.
Issue of what is commonly known as a Suez Canal certificate	£62.50
Unstuffing of overland containers or articulated trailers	£50
Issue of harbour craft passenger certificates	£60”
