## **Port (Fixed Penalty) (Procedure) Rules**

### **ARRANGEMENT OF RULES**

Rule

1. Title
2. Form of notice under section 18A.
3. Copy to be sent to clerk of the magistrates' court.
4. Identification of notice.
5. The full amount of penalty to be accepted.
6. Payment to be refused if criminal proceedings are taken.
7. Issue of receipt.

**Title.**

1. These rules may be cited as the Port (Fixed Penalty) (Procedure) Rules.

**Form of notice under section 18A.**

2.(1) A notice under section 18A (3) of the Act offering the opportunity of the discharge of any liability to conviction of an offence to which that section applies by payment of a fixed penalty (hereinafter in these rules referred to as “a notice”) shall be in the form in the Schedule or in a form to the like effect.

(2) A notice, in specifying an alleged offence, shall contain a reference to the section of the Act or, as the case may be, the rule creating the offence.

**Copy to be sent to clerk of the magistrates' court.**

3. A copy of any notice given under section 18A shall, as soon as practicable, be forwarded by or on behalf of the person giving the notice to the clerk of the magistrates' court.

**Identification of notice.**

4.(1) The person paying a fixed penalty shall either forward with the remittance Part 2 of the relevant notice or identify the notice by specifying its serial number.

(2) If, owing to the failure of the person paying a fixed penalty to comply with the provisions of subrule (1), the clerk of the magistrates' court is unable to identify the relevant notice, the clerk shall, as soon as practicable, return the remittance to that person.

**The full amount of penalty to be accepted.**

5. If less than the full amount of a fixed penalty is tendered to the clerk of the magistrates' court in payment of the fixed penalty the clerk shall, as soon as practicable, return to the sender the amount tendered.

**Payment to be refused if criminal proceedings are taken.**

6. (1) Where criminal proceedings in respect of the act or omission constituting the offence specified in a notice are taken, notification thereof shall, as soon as possible, be given by or on behalf of the prosecutor to the clerk of the magistrates' court.

(2) The clerk shall not, after receiving such notification, accept payment of the fixed penalty to which the notice relates.

**Issue of receipt.**

7. Subject to the preceding provisions of these rules the clerk of the magistrates' court shall, as soon as practicable after payment of a fixed penalty has been made to him –

- (a) send to the payer a receipt for the payment ; and
- (b) inform the Captain of the Port and the Commissioner of Police of the payment.

Cash should be sent by registered post ; cheques, postal orders or money orders should be made payable to the clerk of the magistrates' court.

A receipt for the payment will be given. Part payment will not be accepted by the clerk.
