PORT OPERATIONS (FEES) REGULATIONS 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 16 of the Port Operations (Registration and Licensing) Act 2004, the Minister with responsibility for the Port and Shipping has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Port Operations (Fees) Regulations 2005 and come into operation on a date to be appointed by the Minister with responsibility for the Port and Shipping by notice in the Gazette.

Fees for port operations.

2. The fees set out in Part 1 of the Schedule shall be charged for port operations activities mentioned in that Part.

Fees for registration of port workers.

3. The fees set out in Part 2 of the Schedule shall be charged for registration and re-registration of port workers.

Fees for certificates and licences.

4. The fees set out in Part 3 of the Schedule shall be charged for the issue, renewal, endorsement or amendment of certificates and licences.

Fees for inspection and copies.

5. The fees set out in Part 4 of the Schedule shall be charged for any inspection of a licence and for a certified copy of a licence or certificate.
