## POST OFFICE ACT.

### POSTAL ORDER (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1987.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 54 of the Post Office Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations.

#### **Title.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Postal Order (Amendment) Regulations, 1987.

#### **Amendment to Regulation 3.**

2. Regulation 3 of the Postal Order Regulations (hereinafter called "the principal regulations") is amended:

- (a) in sub-regulation (1)(b) by omitting the words "ten pounds" and substituting therefor the words "twenty pounds"; and
- (b) in sub-regulation (2) by omitting the words "four and one half pence" and substituting therefor the words "nine pence".

#### **Amendment to Regulation 11.**

3. Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is amended-

- (a) in paragraph (2) set out in sub-regulation (2), and
- (b) in proviso (a) (ii) of sub-regulation (4),

by omitting the words "four and one-half pence" and substituting therefor the words "nine pence".

#### **Amendment to Schedule.**

4. The Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by inserting at the end thereof in columns "Denomination" and "Poundage" the expressions-

"£11 to £20"

"65p"

respectively.
