**POST OFFICE ACT.**

**POSTAL ORDER (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1988.**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 54 of the Post Office Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations:

**Title.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Postal Order (Amendment) Regulations, 1988.

**Amendment to regulation 3.**

2. Regulation 3(2) of the Postal Order Regulations (hereinafter called "the principal regulations") is amended by omitting the words "nine pence" and substituting therefor the words "twentyfour pence".

**Amendment to regulation 11.**

3. Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is amended-

(a) in paragraph (2) set out in sub-regulation (2), and

(b) in proviso (a)(ii) of sub-regulation (4),

by omitting the words "nine pence" and substituting therefor the words "twenty-four pence".
