**POST OFFICE ACT.
(Cap. 128).**

**BRITISH COMMONWEALTH AND FOREIGN PARCEL POST
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS. 1985.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 54 of the Post Office Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations:

Title and commencement.

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the British Commonwealth and Foreign Parcel Post (Amendment) Regulations, 1985.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1985.

Amendment of Regulation 16 of Booklet 2 of Cap. 128.

2. Regulation 16 of the British Commonwealth and Foreign Parcel Post Regulations (hereinafter called the principal regulations) is amended –

- (a) in sub-regulation (1) by omitting the expression "£100", and substituting therefor the expression "£750".
- (b) in sub-regulation 3 (a) by omitting the words "ten pence" and substituting therefor the words "fifty pence".

Replacement of Second Schedule.

3. The principal regulations are further amended by revoking the Second Schedule thereto, and substituting therefor the following new Schedule:
