POST OFFICE ACT

COMMONWEALTH AND FOREIGN PARCEL POST (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1987.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 54 of the Post Office Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations:

Title and commencement.

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Commonwealth and Foreign Parcel Post (Amendment 0 Regulations, 1987.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of June, 1987. $\ .$

Amendment of regulation 16.

2. Regulation 16 of the Commonwealth and Foreign Parcel Post Regulations (hereinafter called "the principal regulations") is amended-

- (a) in sub-regulation (1) by omitting the expression "£750" and substituting therefor the expression £1,500";
- (b) in sub-regulation (3) (a) by omitting the words "fifty pence" and substituting therefor the words "seventy-five pence".

Amendment of regulation 17.

3. Regulation 17 of the principal regulations is amended in sub-regulation (1) (e) (ii) by omitting the expression "£80" and substituting therefor the expression "£1,000".

Amendment of regulation 18.

4. Regulation 18 of the principal regulations is amended in proviso (c) to sub-regulation (1) by omitting the expression " $\pounds 80$ " and substituting therefor the expression $\pounds 1,000$ "

Amendment of schedule 2.

5. Schedule 2 to the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expressions "£750" and "£3" and substituting therefor the expressions "£1,500" and "£4.00" respectively.

Amendment of schedule 3.

6. Schedule 3 to the principal regulations is amended by revoking Part I (Insured Parcels) and substituting therefor the following Part-
