POST OFFICE ACT.

LOCAL POST (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1986.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections S and 54 of the Post Office Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations:

Title and commencement.

1.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Local Post (Amendment) Regulations, 1986.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of March, 1986.

Amendment of Regulation 20.

2. Regulation 20(1) of the Local Post Regulations (hereinafter called the principal regulations) is amended by omitting the expression "£1.00" and substituting therefor the expression "£1.20".

Amendment of Regulation 24.

3. Regulation 24(2) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the words "eighty pence" and substituting therefor the expression " $\pounds 1.00$ ".

Amendment of Regulation 29.

4. Regulation 29 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression "£12" and substituting therefor the expression "£15".

Amendment of Schedule 1.

5. Schedule 1 to the principal regulations is amended by omitting Item 8 thereof, and substituting therefor the following new items:
